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A cooperative work
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enclose the venous sinuses. Identify the superior
 sagittal sinus and the right and left transverse si-
 nuses (Fig. 7.13). With scissors, cut these sinuses
 open. Examine closely the superior sagittal sinus and
 verify that:
 • It increases in caliber as it passes posteriorly (on ex-
 mination of venous blood flow)
 • It is triangular on transverse section (Fig. 7.14).
 • It has lateral expansions, the lacunae (Fig. 7.14).
 In relation to the superior sagittal sinus and
 lacunae, observe the following conditions: (1) the
 the arachnoid granulations (Fig. 7.14).
